Shodan / 1st Dan Black Belt

Increased proficiency in all previous techniques.

Perform (5) 3 minute sparring matches back to back with 1 minute rest between. Utilize as many techniques as possible to show proficiency during the matches.

*Reset to starting or other position as determined by the panel at tap out.

No rest during matches. ***Excessive stalling on the part of the Shodan Candidate shall be grounds for failure at the discretion of the board.

In the event of injury the match will be stopped to render treatment. If the decision is made to stop further matches, the Candidate will retest on the sparring portion at a later date. No Certificate or Belt will be awarded until all phases of testing are complete.

Sparring may be waived ONLY on the unanimous decision of the panel and only in the case of advanced age or other mitigating situations such as health conditions that would make such testing risky.

Sparring rules may be altered to adapt to special situations with panel agreement.
